Policy and Fee Structure

Affiliate Membership - (no voting rights at the Annual General Meeting but can attend the AGM)

As an affiliate member you will receive notifications of ATSIMA activities. There is no cost to be an affiliate member. You do not have to renew your membership each year if you are an affiliate member.

Ordinary Membership – (voting rights at the Annual General Meeting)

This membership type is available to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people

 - Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Organisation - (an Aboriginal owned company incorporated under The Office of the Registrar of Indigenous Corporation (ORIC) or an Incorporated body that is Aboriginal owned or has an Aboriginal Board)

Associate Member – (no voting rights at the Annual General Meeting but can attend the AGM)

This membership type is available to non-Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people

- Associate Membership categories
 - Individual
 - Students – (full time student at a recognised high school or tertiary institution)
 - Organisation (an Incorporated Company)

Membership period

- July to June financial year – Renewals commence in March of each year and continue to September if not renewed by end of September membership ceases.
- For new memberships - Membership commences on the date on which the membership form is lodged and the full year membership fee is paid.
